## Omuta Ecotown Seeks to Become the Mecca of the Environmental/Recycling Industry

- Omuta City is located in Kyushu, which serves as an information center for the environmental industry. Approved by the Ministries of International Trade & Industry and Welfare as the nation's fifth ecotown area, Omuta City has been engaged in creating and promoting the environmental/recycling industry as one of the City's most important projects.
- The City provides support at every phase of environmental and recycling-related project creation, from research to project development based on the research. Such support efforts include construction of rental laboratories and industrial complexes, as well as development of sites for demonstration plants.
- With various recycling laws enacted, including the Basic Law for the Promotion of a Recycling Society, it is expected that the movement to establish a recycling society will accelerate in the future. In view of this eventuality, Omuta City is determined to seek zero-emissions by integrating the environmental and recycling industries.
